And also the approximate 10,400 seriously injured, disabled and subsequently psychologically affected professional drivers, key workers and the industry's associated workforce such as, drivers mates and porters that are affected every year in the U.K. On some occasions they or their families may not even receive any financial reconciliation whatsoever for their losses.

We seek to change this at Globetruckers and we will never stop on our mission to strive to help those who have always helped us as the great British public by delivering everything in our lives on a daily basis, who have worked tirelessly and unconditionally during the COVID-19 pandemic, and at all times in the past and present through rain sleet and snow. Who have unfortunately become injured, deceased, disabled and psychologically affected and disenfranchised in the process as an overall result. We aim to help the people that may even feel severely psychologically affected, while on the road. Those who have the unfortunate experience of



injuries, loss or accidents and experiences of losing their jobs through no fault of their own. In some cases, causing them suicidal tendencies and break down of relationships.

working tirelessly, but, completely free of reward, wages or any other financial gain whatsoever purely to help the people who need it most and have been through the same as me and even worse. All because we at Globetruckers have an extremely big heart and an adverse will to help others. We will strive to continue to do this in order to help our charity to succeed and to satisfy our need to help others no matter how difficult.



How about a sponsored bike ride,



Fancy a nice brew? Having an in-depth discussion over a gorgeous brew is a simple way raise money. Technically


you could hold it at work, your local church or even at home.


Is gaming your thing.....


How about getting your boss's legs waxed!
